

1. The earth is the LORD's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it;	Psalms 24:1

126. Just as the living Father sent me and I live because of the Father, so the one who feeds on me will live because of me.	John 6:57

137. Confessing their sins, they were baptized by him in the Jordan River.	Matthew 3:6

153. Paul and Barnabas appointed elders for them in each church and, with prayer and fasting, committed them to the Lord, in whom they had put their trust.	Acts 14:23
154. Not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock.	1 Peter 5:3
155. The elders who direct the affairs of the church well are worthy of double honor, especially those whose work is preaching and teaching.	1 Timothy 5:17

156. Nevertheless, the one who receives instruction in the word should share all good things with their instructor.	Galatians 6:6
157. They must keep hold of the deep truths of the faith with a clear conscience.	1 Timothy 3:9

163. Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything.	Ephesians 5:24
164. Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her	Ephesians 5:25
165. In this same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself.	Ephesians 5:28
166. The wise woman builds her house, but with her own hands the foolish one tears hers down.	Proverbs 14:1
167. And Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding.	John 2:2
168. However, each one of you also must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband.	Ephesians 5:33
169. Wives, submit yourselves to your husbands, as is fitting in the Lord.	Colossians 3:18
170. Husbands, love your wives and do not be harsh with them	Colossians 3:19

13. HOLY UNCTION (Anointing the sick)

171. They drove out many demons and anointed many sick people with oil and healed them.	Mark 6:13
172. Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord.	James 5:14
173. And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up. If they have sinned, they will be forgiven.	James 5:15
174. Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.	James 5:16
175. "Neither this man nor his parents sinned," said Jesus, "but this happened so that the works of God might be displayed in him."	John 9:3
